PASSING SHADOW

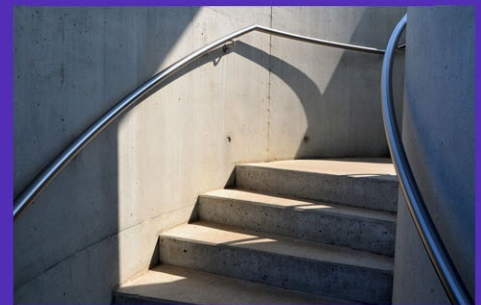
